1. Adult in charge must be 21 years or older. All other adults must be at least 18.
2. Adult leaders must complete "Safety Afloat Training", No.1459, have a Commitment Card" with them, and be dedicated to full compliance with all nine points of Safety Afloat.

QUALIFIED SUPERVISION-All activity afloat must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult over 21 years of age who understands and knowingly accepts responsibility for the well being and safety of the children in his or her care, who is experienced and qualified in the particular watercraft skills and equipment involved in the activity, and who is committed to compliance with the nine points of BSA Safety Afloat. One such supervisor is required for each ten people, with a minimum of two adults for any one group. All supervisors must complete BSA Safety Afloat and Safe Swim Defense training, and at least one must be certified in CPR. (It is strongly recommended that all units have at least one adult or older youth member currently certified as a BSA Lifeguard to assist in the planning and conduct of all activity afloat.)

3. The unit accepts full financial responsibility for the cost of any repairs necessary to equipment upon its return. The cost to replace a damaged paddle is \$10.00 each and to replace a damaged life preserver is \$20.00 each. Other damage assessed at replacement cost.

The unit committee has read and understands the requirements as stated above. The unit committee and the adult in charge are aware that water activities increase exposure to accidents and will make every effort to follow the above requirements. The unit also accepts full financial responsibility for damaged or lost council equipment.
