- Each unit must report to the Campmaster or Ranger upon arrival.
- No pets allowed at camp.
- No vehicles are to be driven past the parking area.
- Each unit must have proper adult supervision.
- No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances are allowed at camp.
- Do not leave fires unattended.
- Parking lot latrines are closed from October 31 to March 15.
- No boats can be launched at camp.
- Practice BSA's Leave No Trace camping.
- The floating dock and Lope course is off limits.
- All trash goes home with you or you use the dumpster at the dining hall.
- No throwing rocks along the rip rap.
- If you have any injuries or problems please report them to the Campmaster or Ranger.
- Each unit must check out with the Campmaster or Ranger.

We have read and understand the rules governing the use of Council Camps. We also understand that if any damage is done to camp property that is determined to be caused by our unit we will be responsible for the repair.
