RULES OF CAMP

Your unit will be expected. If you will be at camp earlier, later, or if you cancel you **MUST** notify the ranger.

- Troop trailers are allowed in campsite, all other vehicles must be parked at the parking lot and not in campsite.
- No pets allowed in campsites.
- No climbing on trees.
- Fires must only be in established fire rings.
- Practice BSA's Leave No Trace.
- **Do not leave a fire unattended;** make sure fires are dead out.
- Make sure latrines are kept in working order and kept clean.
- You will need to supply your own toilet paper.
- Take all trash with you when you leave, including trash in the latrine.
- Ranger has a recycle container for aluminum cans only.
- **Campsites should be smoke free environment.** No smoking except at the designated area next to the boat shed.
- Unused firewood should be placed back in the designated woodpile. Firewood should be cut to appropriate size at the woodpile before bringing to campsite, following the ax yard rules.
- All aquatics **must** be conducted in accordance with BSA Safety Afloat and Safe Swim Defense policies. **No exceptions!**
- Police the area of the camp you used to make sure it is left better than you found it.
- Set up a checkout campsite inspection with the Ranger before you leave.
- If you have any injuries or problems please report them to the Ranger.
